#### Cleaner Air Project - We've won!

We've been working with around 20 schools and Hampshire County Council this year to see how we can improve the air quality in our locality. Specifically, our ecocommittee and JRSOs have been thinking about solutions. They submitted an action plan as part of the project, and we're pleased to say their plan was chosen above the 20 schools! As you may be aware, our Junior Road Safety Officers and Eco Committee have joined forces and have been working together over the past few months on our Cleaner Air Campaign. The aim of the campaign is to improve air quality and reduce traffic congestion. One of the main concerns that has arisen is the amount of traffic around school at drop off and pick up times and the impact that this has on our air quality. With this in mind, next week is Walk To School Week so there's no better time to think about leaving that car behind and walking for all or maybe some of your journey if possible. We all know that walking has many health benefits- it is good for general well-being and is a great opportunity to spend time talking to our children and noticing and admiring things in our natural environment. We also know that by walking we are reducing the amount of emissions we are putting into the air and making our environment a healthier place.
