## Extra Funding for our school?

We can get extra funding to support the learning of our pupils. This is called Pupil Premium funding, and we receive this funding for pupils whose parents receive certain benefits.

Your child is entitled for the Pupil Premium if you receive any of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-based Job Seekers' Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- The Guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit, and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190.

If you think your child is eligible, please register at [www.hants.gov.uk/hc3s/freeschoolmeals](http://www.hants.gov.uk/hc3s/freeschoolmeals). Click 'I would like to check for free meal eligibility. It's a very quick form, and you find out straight away.
