
A Message From Mr Applegate

We are looking forward to Sports Day on Friday! A few reminders:

KS2 sports day will start at 9.15am.
Whole school (including parents) picnic lunch
between 12.00pm – 12.35pm.
KS1 sports will start at 1.00pm - we will be finished
by the end of the school day.

- a) Children will need sunscreen applied before school, and also have a water bottle and sun hat at the ready.
- b) There is a picnic lunch at 12pm, joint with KS1 and KS2 (30 minute lunch!). Remember to send your child in with a lunch anyway just in case Sports Day is cancelled due to weather.
- c) Sports Day starts with collaborative yet competitive colour team activities in a carousel fashion, and then moves into traditional races after a song to warm your hearts. Please don't setup chairs or picnic blankets too early as you may be asked to move! Best to wait until after the carousel colour team activities have taken place.
- d) Children should come to school dressed in PE kit, wearing the coloured t-shirt for their team, without big logos if possible.
- e) Parking will be difficult- so be prepared to walk! The car park will already be extremely full.

Price Increases

It's been over 8 years since Breakfast Club prices have increased. From September, the current charge of £2.00 will increase to £2.50. For those joining at 8:20am, the charge will still be £1.00.

Further, after school clubs run by Planet Education will carry a small surcharge of £1 per session. Staff led clubs will still be free. We feel this provides excellent value. Many schools charge £4+ for either breakfast club or after school clubs.

Also, HC3S who run the school dinners have asked us to inform parents that the cost of a school dinner will increase to £2.30 from September 2018.


