




## Examples of Blurbs



"A mouse took a stroll through the deep dark wood. A fox saw the mouse and the mouse looked good."


Walk further into the deep dark wood and discover what happens when the quick thinking mouse comes face to face with n owl, a snake and a hungry Gruffalo...
