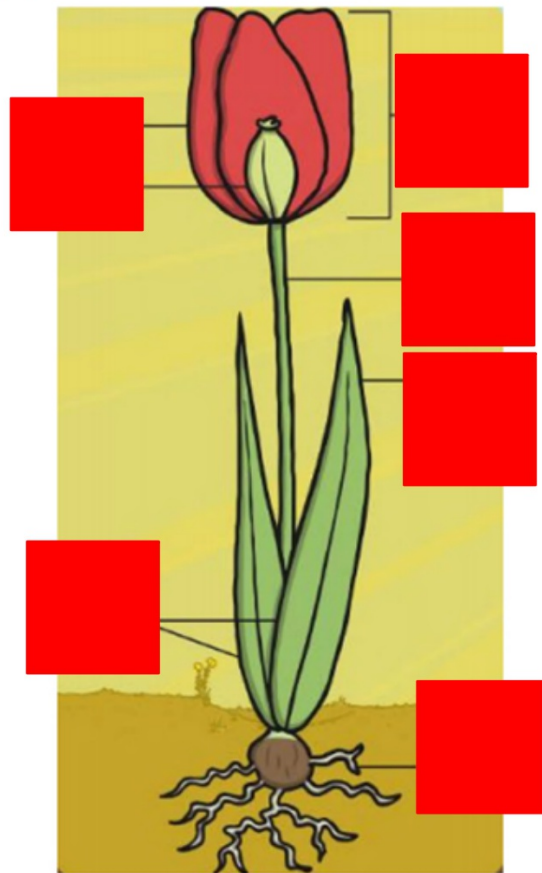
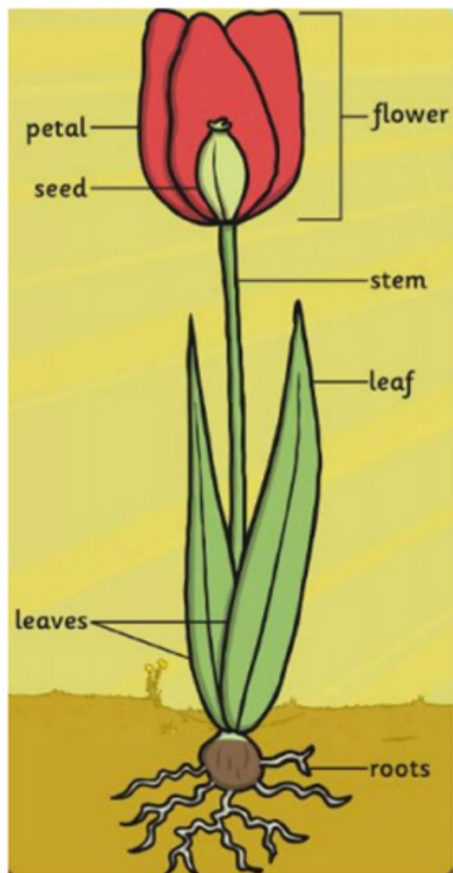


Can you name any parts of this flower? What does each part do?

What do you think each part does?

We're going to be looking at 4 main parts of the flower today:

leaf

petal

stem

root

Can you spot these parts on the flower?

Do you know what these parts do?

## Roots

What do they do?  
What are they for?

Roots suck up water into the plant.

They stretch into the ground to reach the water and nutrients.

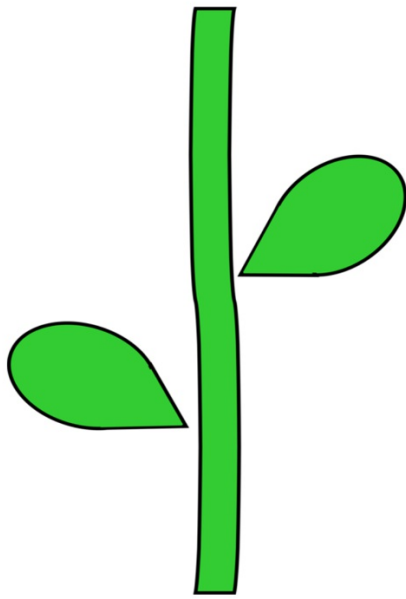
They keep the plant upright.



Flower

What does it do?  
What is it for?

The flower is bright and colourful to attract insects.  
It often holds pollen for bees to collect.  
Sometimes flowers can be fruit.



## Stem

What does it do?

What is it for?

The stem takes water from the roots to the rest of the plant.

It grows tall so the plant can get closer to the sun.

It holds the leaves.



## Leaves

What do they do?  
What are they for?

Leaves turn energy from the sun into food for the plant.  
They help the plant to breathe.
