## How to Plant a Seed

Have a look at these instructions for planting seeds to remind you.  
What bossy doing words can you spot? What do you notice about where they are in the sentence?

1



Fill half your plant pot with soil.

2



Sprinkle your seeds onto the soil.

3



Pour more soil over the seeds.

4



Use the watering can to dampen the soil.

5



Set your plant pot by a window for sunlight.

6



Water your seeds regularly.

## How to Plant a Seed

See if you can talk through the steps of how to plant a seed with someone at home.

What happened first? What is the last step?

Use the template or your own paper to write some instructions for how to plant a seed. Make sure you use **full stops and capital letters!**

See if you can include a 'you will need:' list and use as many **bossy doing words** as you can!

As an extra challenge, see if you can use '**and**' or add any **adjectives** to your instructions. For example:

**F**ill your pot with **crumbly and brown** soil.  
**G**et a **big** watering can **and** **water** your **tiny** seeds.
