The children have a go at Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check. We encourage them to think about what the word looks like in books they have read. Does it look right?

### 3) Spelling sentences

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I can use key words when spelling.

Practise writing out this week's Spelling Sentence in your book. Remember capital letters and full stops.

We read the spelling sentences out to the children and they have a go at putting the words into the sentence. After we have checked they are spelt correctly, the children have a go at writing the sentences.

I *saw three children*. The old man is called Bob.

I *just made a cake*.
