Tro tros

Tro tros are privately owned minivans that hold approximately 16 to 24 people and are designed to hold as much luggage as people. Tro tros are uncomfortable but offer a very exciting adventure. They are good for

short journeys.



You can hail a tro tro anywhere along the road or from outside the terminal. There is no timetable nor a map with a route. Tro tros wait until they are full and then it's ready for departure.

Buses are usually used for longer distances and between most major cities. There are plenty of bus companies that offer the same routes.



Taxis are plentiful, and are undoubtedly the best bet for people new to Accra. There are plenty -as you will notice from the constant beeping to get your attention.
