Our aims in using our sports funding this year are as follows:

1. Provide staff with high quality planning to support the development of the quality of teaching.
2. Develop a clear skills-progression throughout the school.
3. Develop the skills of our new PE leadership team.
4. Promote being physically active at play times.
5. Enable a wide provision of after-school sports clubs to be offered and continue participation in a range of inter school competitions.
6. Increase lunchtime sports provision.

Sporting events	£300	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children learn the competitive side of physical education. • Form networks with different schools and PE leaders.
