Through Maths, we will continue to practise our counting skills within 100 and counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will continue to develop our understanding of addition and subtraction, solving these using a number line. We will also be looking at telling the time this term to the nearest hour and half past the hour.

During our **PE** this term, the children will be outdoors developing their athletics skills. We will also learn more about sending and receiving by learning some tennis skills.

In Art and Design, the children will look at leaf and bark printing and create their own leaf man or leaf animal.

During our **PSHE** this term, we will explore the idea of a journey and whether they are good, bad or both. We will think about changes and how our actions affect others.

Our RE we will explore the concept of Authority. The children will think about the people in their lives that show authority and why they are important. We will then relate this to Christianity and think about how Jesus and God show authority and love in the Bible.

In **Science** this term will be think about plants and focus on trees by identifying and naming them. We will also learn to name the different parts of a tree.

Through **Computing**, we will think about programming using Bee-bots. We will develop skills which will enable us to sequence sets of instructions to move the Bee-bots to reach specific points and manoeuvre them across maps.

Our **Geography** learning will focus on simple mapping skills. We will learn about physical and human features found on a map and in our surroundings and learn to draw a simple map using some of these features.

In English this term, we will be looking at different traditional tales and exploring the journeys the characters have taken. We will be writing our own versions of stories read. We will continue to develop our knowledge and use of full stops and capital letters and making sure our sentences make sense. Phonics and reading will continue to happen every day. Please continue to read frequently with your child at home, it really does help them. Spellings will continue to be sent home every week on Google classrooms for the children to learn.
