

ROMAN SOLDIER DAY

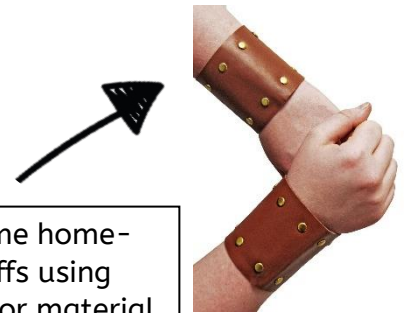
