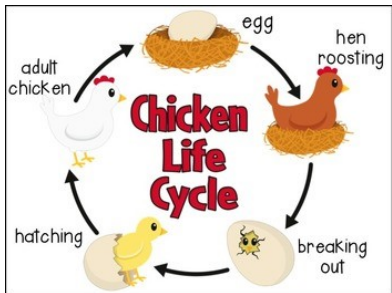
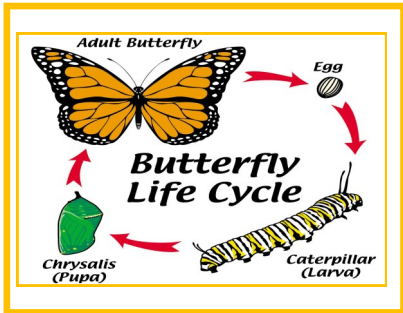

Some animals give birth to **live young**.



Some animals lay eggs which the **young** hatch from.



Both of these types of **young** then **develop** into **adults**.

Lifecycles

A life cycle is the journey of a living thing from beginning to end. All young animals change as they go through the different stages of their life cycle and grow into adults.



Key Vocabulary

adult	A fully grown animal or plant.
develop	To grow bigger and become stronger.
life cycle	The changes living things go through to become an adult.
offspring	The child of an animal.
young	Offspring that has not reached adulthood.
live young	Offspring that has not hatched from an egg.
