Dear Parents/Carers,

Last week, you donated some money a non-uniform day. We recommended 70p for the Jubilee. We are now giving you back your 70p and we would like you to 'Grow a 70p for the Jubilee project'.

What does this mean?

Over the next 3 weeks all children throughout the school will be given the challenge of using the 70p we have included with this letter to raise as much money as possible.

How can you increase your money?

You may wish to use the 70p to buy ingredients for cakes or biscuits, for example, which you could sell in a cake sale, or use the money to buy sponges and buckets to wash cars. Alternatively, groups of children or families may combine their money and work collectively on a project.
