4. Promote being physically active at play times.
5. Develop personal, social, physical and cognitive skills to help children's attitude to physical education.
6. Enable a wide provision of after-school sports clubs to be offered and continue participation in a range of inter school competitions.
7. Increase lunchtime sports opportunities.
