Human Feature - Are things that are built by humans such as bridges, buildings and roads.





River Seine is a 777 kilometers (483 miles) long river. It is an important commercial waterway. The Seine source is a height of 471 meters above sea level. At the mouth of the river it is 16 kilometers (10 miles) wide.
