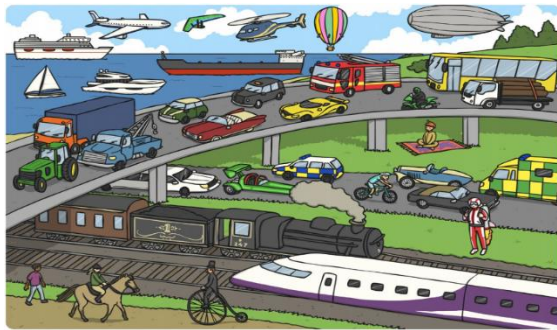








How many different modes of transport can you spot in the picture?

1862  After many years in the shipbuilding industry, John Thornycroft designed his first steam car.	1872  He set up his company calling it, Thornycroft and Co.	1895  They built their first steam road vehicle.	1898  They opened a factory in Basingstoke to sell steam wagons.	1902  They started building Thornycroft cars in the Basingstoke factory, becoming a major employer for the town.	1912  They stopped building cars and focused on lorries, ships and vans, supplying vehicles to the military.

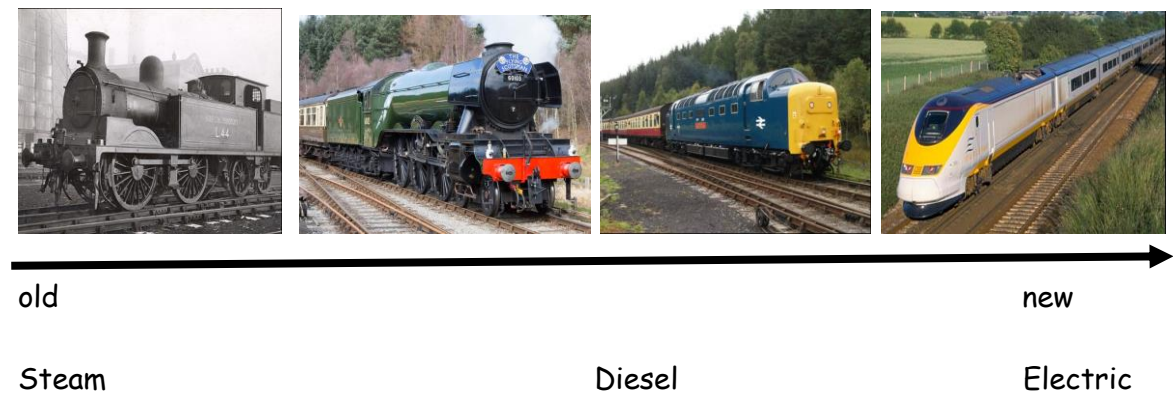
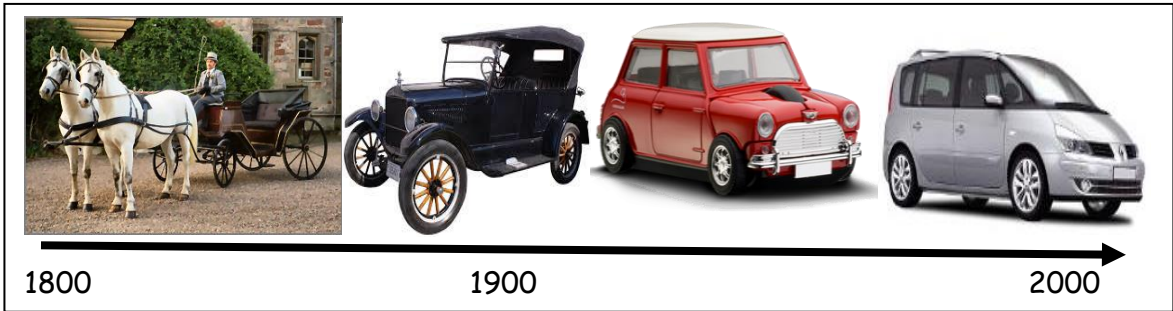
