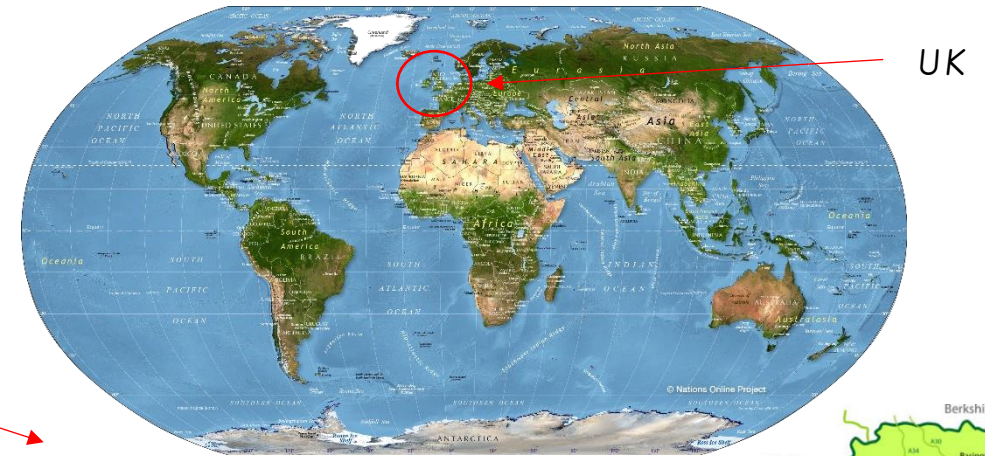
There are 3 cities in Hampshire.
