chariot - A cart with two wheels pulled by horses

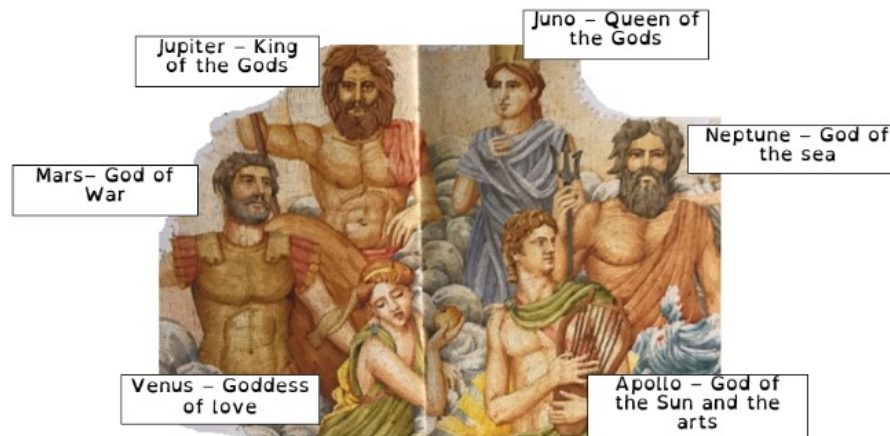
mosaic - A pattern made from coloured pieces of stones and pottery

villa—A large house in the country, either like palaces or farmhouses

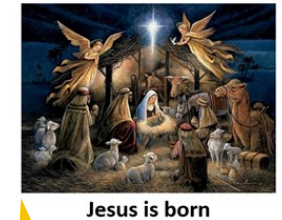
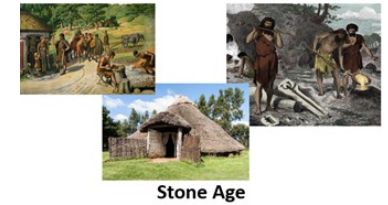
