

Branches – the parts that grow out from the trunk of a tree and have leaves, flowers and fruit growing on them.

Trunk – the large main stem of a tree from which the branches grow.

Bark – a tough material that covers the outside of the tree.


Things to try at home to support learning...

- Create a map of your favourite park.




deciduous
