What do plants need to grow well?

| sunlight | All plants need light from the sun to grow <br> well. Some plants need lots of sunlight. <br> Some plants only need a little sunlight. |
| :--- | :--- |
| water | All plants need water to grow. Without <br> water, seeds and bulbs will not germinate. |
| temperature | Temperature is how warm or cold <br> something or somewhere is. Some plants <br> like cooler temperatures and some like <br> warmer temperatures. |
| nutrition | Food or nourishment. Plants make their <br> own food in their leaves using sunlight. |
