The Vikings used trading ships which were known as a knörr ship - a wider boat which carried less people but more cargo. The longship was the ship that Vikings used for raiding. It was around 20 metres long but only 2-3 metres wide. It was slim and strongly built of timber. It slid easily through the waves and was powered by a large square sail or long oars.
