Bark	Is the outer layer of a tree.	Leaves
Branch	The parts of a tree that grow out from its trunk and often have leaves growing on them.	Bark
Bud	A small growth on a branch that later grows into a flower or leaf.	
Deciduous tree	A tree that shed their leaves in winter. Their leaves are usually wide and flat.	Types of trees
Evergreen tree	A tree that keeps their leaves all year round. They often have leaves shaped like needles.	Silver Pine
Leaf	Usually flat green parts that grow from a plant stem or branch.	birch tree
Root	The part of a plant that grows downwards and holds the plant or tree in place and takes in water from the soil.	Sycamore Beech tree
Seed	The small hard part of a plant from which a new plant grows.	Horse
Shoot	The plant that comes up above the ground when it begins to grow.	Holly Chestnut
Trunk	The main stem of a tree apart from the branches or roots.	Field maple Oak tree
