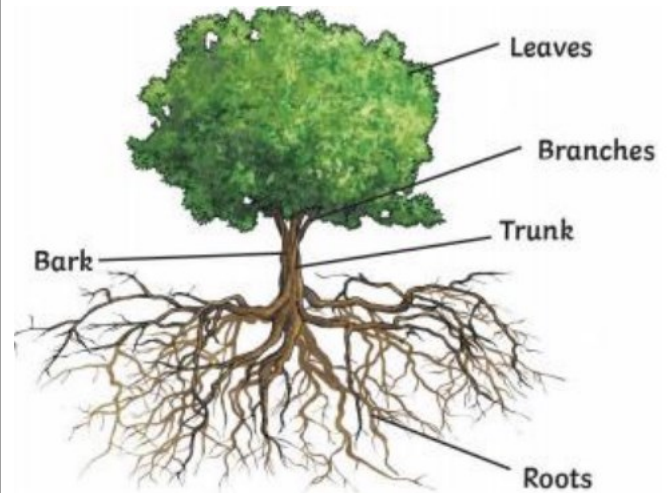




## Vocabulary Top Ten:

Bark	Is the outer layer of a tree.
Branch	The parts of a tree that grow out from its trunk and often have leaves growing on them.
Bud	A small growth on a branch that later grows into a flower or leaf.
Deciduous tree	A tree that shed their leaves in winter. Their leaves are usually wide and flat.
Evergreen tree	A tree that keeps their leaves all year round. They often have leaves shaped like needles.
Leaf	Usually flat green parts that grow from a plant stem or branch.
Root	The part of a plant that grows downwards and holds the plant or tree in place and takes in water from the soil.
Seed	The small hard part of a plant from which a new plant grows.
Shoot	The plant that comes up above the ground when it begins to grow.
Trunk	The main stem of a tree apart from the branches or roots.

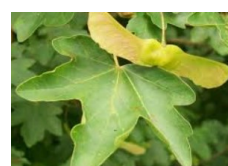
