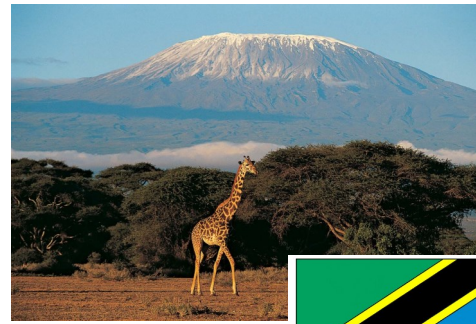
Key Vocabulary

fresh water	Water that has no salt in it.
mine	A pit or excavation site in the earth from which mineral substances are taken.
season	Seasons are periods of the year that are distinguished by special climate conditions. The four seasons - spring, summer, autumn and winter - follow one another.
soil	The top layer of earth.
vegetation	Plant life.
village	A place where people live, usually in the countryside, smaller than a town.
weather	Day-to-day conditions.



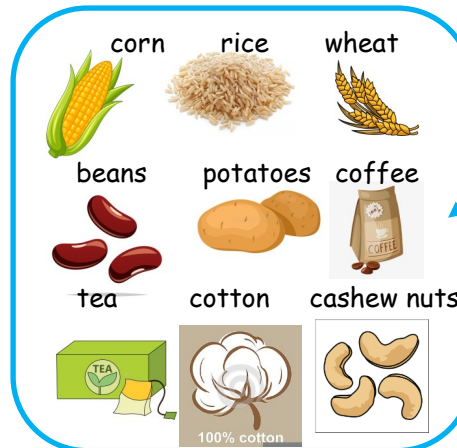
Lake Victoria is the largest freshwater lake in the world.
