

Vocabulary Top Ten:	
Bud	A small growth on a branch that later grows into a flower or leaf.
Bulb	This is the name given to the underground part of the plant before it grows.
Flower	Often brightly coloured growing at the end of a stem.
Leaf	Usually flat green parts that grow from a plant stem or branch.
Petal	Thin coloured or white parts which form the flower.
Root	The part of a plant that grows downwards and holds the plant or tree in place and takes in water from the soil.
Seed	The small hard part of a plant from which a new plant grows.
Shoot	The plant that comes up above the ground when it begins to grow.
Stem	Thin upright part on which flowers and leaves grow.
