For <u>Maths</u> this half term we are starting with telling the time to 5 minute intervals. We will be solving problems about days, weeks, months and years before moving onto learning about obtuse, acute and right angles. We then explore horizontal, vertical, parallel and perpendicular lines and use this vocabulary to help describe shapes.


<u>PE</u> Please ensure your child comes to school dressed in PE kit every Tuesday and Friday. This term we will be focusing rounders and health and fitness skills.

Through our <u>Computing</u> unit children will have the opportunity to write a story board, use an iPad to take photos and add transitions between shots to create a book trailer.

In <u>RE</u> we will be exploring the concept of protection, by linking it to our own experiences before discovering how Hindus celebrate protection in Raksha Bandhan.

This term the children will take part in French lessons. Our topic will be Je Peux. The children will begin to recognise some common French verbs and use them with Je peux.... (I can...)

Rotten Romans



This term, Year 3 will explore the big question:

What did the Romans do for us?

We will be having a Roman Workshop on **Monday 26**th **June** where we will encourage the children to dress

up!

History forms our topic driver for this half term, and we will be focussing on the era of the Romans. We will look at the reasons why they invaded, what made the Roman Empire powerful and who tried to resist their invasion. We will also be thinking about the legacy left behind by the Romans, ultimately leading us to answer the question 'What did the Romans do for us?'

Our <u>English</u> will involve writing a poem based on the book The Night Box by Louise Greig. We will look at the shape of the poem in our sentence stacking lessons and use our knowledge of the dark to inspire us. The Secret of Black Rock by Joe Todd-Stanton will be the focus for our story writing.

In Art children will explore Roman art and architecture and represent their ideas through the medium of drawing. They will use shading techniques to show depth and texture, and identify how the visual elements of line, shape and space are used to create this distinctive style.

Our <u>Science</u> focus will be to explore light and think about sun safety. We will investigate shadows, including how they are formed and why they change size and shape.

Children will continue to take part in 'Listen to Me' <u>Music</u> lessons every week. Our African Drumming session will be on Tuesday 18th July.
