Maths

Through Maths, we will be practising our counting within 20, both forwards and backwards and become confident at reading and writing these numbers correctly. We will learn about ways of making our numbers within 10 and use different resources and pictures to help us solve problem.

RE

In our <u>RE</u> learning this term, we will be thinking about rules and exploring how rules are part of Jewish customs and beliefs.

This half term in PE, we will be indoors exploring the fundamental skills of balancing, running, changing direction, jumping, hopping and skipping. During our outdoor sessions, we will focus on developing our athletic skills, like running at different speeds, changing direction, jumping and throwing. Please ensure your child is wearing their Active Wear uniform on Mondays (Indoor PE) and Thursday (Outdoor PE).

Computing

Through Computing, we will learn about how to use a computer safely; turning it on and off correctly and logging on and off. We will also be learn to use the keyboard to type simple words.

Science

In Science this term, we will be thinking about humans and their senses. We will learn different parts of the body and find out how our senses link to these.

Sensational Senses



Our project will explore the big question, 'Are senses important and how are they affected by the world around us?'

PSHE / Heartsmart

During our PSHE this term, we will explore the idea of teamwork and how we can work alongside each other. We will create our class charters and explore how rules are used to help us in our learning. We will also continue our work with Borris the Robot in Heartsmart.



Art

In Art, the children will be exploring the use of colour through painting. We will learn about primary and secondary colours and learn to mix colours. We will use our knowledge of colour-mixing to create paintings linked to artists such as Matisse and Kandinsky.

Music

In Music, we will be enjoying exploring and experimenting with pulse and rhythm in our "My Favourite Things' unit.

English

In English this term, we will be exploring familiar stories, including 'The Hungry Caterpillar' and 'The Enormous Turnip', where we will talk about the texts and learn to retell them in simple words and sentences. We will also be looking at poetry and thinking about the senses to write our own poetry about St Mark's.

Readina

Reading happens daily within our RWI phonics sessions. Additionally, children will read with classroom adults across the week. Please can you read frequently with your child at home as it really does help them to progress and grow in confidence. Four reads a week earns a raffle ticket for the half termly book prize.
