MATHS

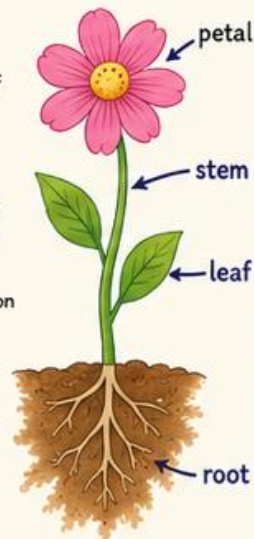
- We will broaden our knowledge of numbers to 100 and practise how to read and write them correctly.

- We will also be learning to tell time, using analogue clocks and reading the time to the hour and half hour.
- Later in the term, we will use our addition and subtraction knowledge to help us solve problems involving money.
